Day 2 – Sunday:

In the morning, visit (no guide included) of the exhibition: "Joan Mitchell, 1926–1992", which is held at Palazzo Magnani.

Lunch at a local restaurant.

In the afternoon, you may wish to continue your visit of the exhibitions part of European Photography and of the historical city center.
